

## **TRANSACTIONAL ANALYSIS Two day introductory course**

Transactional Analysis (TA) offers a therapeutic perspective on how people are made up psychologically and how we communicate with each other. TA provides a way to understand patterns we may use in our relationships with each other. TA offers a way forward for personal growth and change. It can be applied in interpersonal, educational or organisational settings.

The course is ideal for people who seek practical skills and theoretical perspectives that will improve communication and contribute to the development of meaningful interpersonal relationships.

### **Who would benefit from attending this course?**

Individuals, team leaders, project managers, health professionals, psychotherapists, people in any helping profession, managers, clinicians, human resource personnel, counsellors teachers, group facilitators; relationship partners.

### **Learning outcomes**

Discussion of core Transactional Analysis theory.

Understanding of communication processes.

Consideration of individual and group dynamics, and the impact these have on work and personal situations.

Discussion of ego states as aspects of self and early relationship patterns.

Understanding life scripts and the life plan we unconsciously make in early life and tend to live out.

An understanding of patterns in our personal and professional lives.

An understanding of repetitive patterns of behaviour and communication.

This 12 hour training stands on its own as an introduction to the fundamental concepts of Transactional Analysis. It is also a prerequisite for those wanting to advance to further training. On satisfactory completion of the workshop, participants will receive the TA101 Certificate as defined by the International Transactional Analysis Association.
