Transactional Analysis is a practical psychological theory, useful for working with people in a variety of fields. It can be used as a simple model, easily applied in the workplace, classroom or counselling situation, while at an advanced level it becomes a profound developmental theory and psychotherapeutic method.

The TA 101 is an introductory course that conforms to an international standard. It looks at ego development through the lens of a clear model and provides a series of tools for understanding and changing the way we think, feel and behave, in a contractual way. This two day experiential workshop includes, teaching, exercises and interaction.

The TA 101 course is suitable for, but not limited to, trainees and practitioners in counselling, psychotherapy, education and management. It may be used as a beginning to further training in Transactional Analysis, or may stand alone as a useful addition to a practitioner's repertoire and a tool for self development.
